We are pleased to inform you that the Indian Nursing Council in partnership with the UNFPA (United Nations Population Fund) is organizing a virtual capacity building program for the midwifery faculty in the Schools and Colleges of Nursing in India.

Training objective:

The capacity building program prepares faculty to

- Enhance the teaching and training skills of the faculty teaching midwifery at schools and colleges of nursing.
- Update their knowledge based on the government of India guidelines on maternal and newborn health, family planning services, adolescent health and gender based violence.

Training plan:

Six days virtual program with 3 hours sessions on Zoom platform each day

Topics covered :

Educational methodology and latest educational technology, midwifery education and practice concepts, maternal health programs of Government of India, evidence based midwifery care, contraception and family welfare services, gender based violence, adolescent and young people's sexual and reproductive health.

Participants:

Three to four Nursing faculty from each institution who are involved in teaching of OBG nursing, Pediatrics or Community health nursing in GNM/ B.Sc (N) can participate. Preference is given for OBG faculty.

Clinical nurse midwives working in the maternity unit of affiliated hospitals can also participate.

Certification:

Certificate of completion with 15 CNE credit hours will be provided to participants who have full attendance and who score 70% marks in the post test and assignment evaluation.

Training fee:

Completely FREE
