August 13th is celebrated as World Organ Donation day. India celebrates its Organ Donation day on 27th November across the country. The aim of this day is to motivate normal human beings to pledge to donate organs after death, and to spread awareness about the importance of organ donation.

Organ Donation and transplantation is permitted by law, and is covered under the “Transplantation of Human Organs Act (THOA) 1994”, which has allowed live and deceased organ donation. Organ Donation is donating a donor's organs like heart, liver, kidneys, intestines, lungs, and pancreas, after the donor dies, for the purpose of transplanting them into another person who is in need of an organ. The organ donor can play a big role in saving others' life. The organ of the donor can be transplanted to the patient who needs it urgently.

National Organ and Tissue Transplant Organization (NOTTO) is a National level organization set up under Directorate General of Health Services, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India for promotion of organ & tissue donation and transplantation in the country.
